



Job Description: Fund Development & Communications Manager

Clackamas Volunteers in Medicine (CVIM), located in Oregon City, OR, is hiring a .6 FTE Fund Development and Communications Manager to be part of the leadership team responsible for growing and sustaining the organization. CVIM is a community-supported nonprofit providing free primary medical care to low-income and uninsured adults living in Clackamas County.

Reporting to the Executive Director, the Development and Communications Manager will be responsible for actively supporting the fundraising and communications activities of CVIM. The Development Manager works closely with the Executive Director, the Board Chair, board members and volunteers to identify, solicit and steward gifts in support of CVIM's mission.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to grant writing, donor prospecting, inspiring and supervising volunteers, coordinating annual appeals, event planning and planned giving, managing the donor database (eTapestry) and shaping the agency social media presence. An integral and essential role is the development of effective, targeted communications to all stakeholder groups, continually seeking to inform and inspire.

The Fund Development and Communications Manager will also plan and implement public relations and marketing activities and work to continually raise the visibility of the organization in the community.
